## STARTING YOUR OVERWATCH LEAGUE COLLECTION

There are many different ways to collect trading cards, but a great way to begin is by focusing on your favorite players and teams. Expand your collection and have fun completing sets by trading with other fans on Upper Deck e-Pack. You can also collect insert sets that include parallel versions of top players or season highlights. Organize your collection by collating cards using the numbers found in the top right corner on the card backs. ## OVERVIEW

Overwatch League-licensed trading cards showcase fan-favorite players, key moments, rivalries, league leaders and more! The Inaugural Season set features a 125-player base set from the 12 inaugural Overwatch League teams. The High Series set brings in the 8 expansion teams and Star Rookies from across the entire league. Look for variant versions printed on acetate, as well as foil parallel cards ranging in rarity. Additional Highlights include rare multi-player autograph cards, and match-worn jersey cards.



# PRODUCT DETAILS

## BASE CARDS

Base cards are common cards that account for the largest collection within a trading card product. The Overwatch League Inaugural Season base set consists of 125 individual players featured on one overall design template, with unique color schemes for each of the 12 inaugural teams. The High Series set adds 90 Star Rookies from all 20 teams.

## INSERT SETS

Insert sets are more difficult to find and collect than base cards, and are considered a unique sub-collection within the trading card set. Inserts have a different design than common cards or offer parallel versions of base cards that might incorporate different types of technology, foil, or variant color schemes. Collect entire insert sets (and earn e-Pack achievements) or add insert cards to enhance your collection of teams and players.

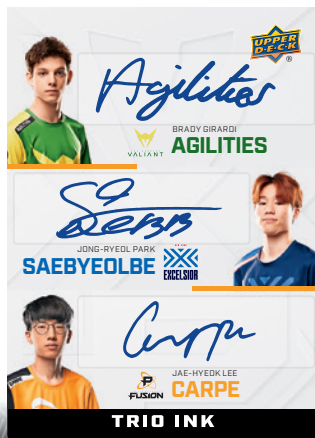
## OVERVIEW OF INSERTS

### Infra-Sight Cards:

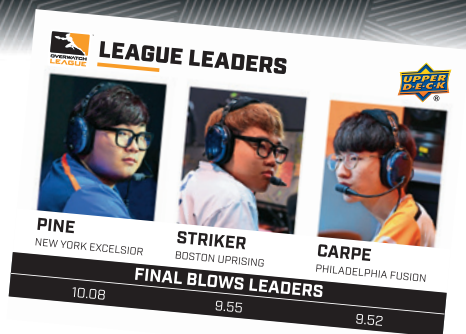
These cards are parallel versions of player base cards, printed directly on clear acetate. This process creates a transparent background that makes the player image pop.

### Map Cards:

Map cards showcase in-game map imagery displayed in arenas during matches. This insert set includes one card for each Overwatch map.







## Star Rookies:

A player's first professional card is considered their rookie card. The Star Rookie insert set features new players in the Overwatch League.

## Season 1 Highlights:

This insert set feature highlights from the inaugural season such as key victories, upsets, winning streaks, and more.

## Team Checklists:

Team checklist cards feature a team logo on the front side and a checklist of player base cards from that specific team on the back, also making it a great centerpiece for your team collection.

## Rivals:

One thing that makes competitive games more exciting is great matchups, and the Rivals insert set does not disappoint. This set features popular rivalries such as Carpe and Gamsu, Surefour and Custa, and Muma and Gesture.

## League Leaders:

These cards showcase the top three players for important statistical categories, including Final Blows, Damage Blocked, and Healing.

## CHASE CARDS

### Solo, Duo, and Trio Ink:

These cards feature one to three autographs from players in the league. Solo Ink cards feature one player autograph. Duo Ink cards feature two different player autographs and are more rare. Trio Ink cards are the rarest version and contain three different player autographs on one card.



### Solo, Duo and Trio Fragments:

Fragment cards feature fabric swatches cut from player jerseys. These cards also come in three rarity tiers, and some are also crash numbered. Solo Fragment cards feature one swatch, while Duo Fragments offer a pair of swatches. The Trio Fragment cards are the most rare and feature three different swatches.



## TRADING CARD VALUES

The value of a trading card is based on many factors, including a player's popularity, the rarity of the card, the brand, the card's condition, and the overall demand from other collectors. Some of the most valuable cards today are tied to a player's rookie year, or have autographs and/or jersey swatches embedded in the cards.

## PROTECTING YOUR COLLECTION

Keep your collection safe, organized, and in good condition by placing cards in special holder sheets inside of a binder. Like most things of value, the better the condition, the more attractive and valuable those items will be. The same is true of trading card collecting. Cards that have bent corners, creases, or other issues that prevent them from being classified as "mint condition" have less value. Rare or valuable single cards can be stored in plastic holders created specifically for trading cards. Accessories like these can be found in local hobby shops or through online retailers.

## GLOSSARY OF TERMS

**Achievement** – A program that rewards collectors for completing specific sets or challenges, exclusively through Upper Deck e-Pack.

**Auto Card** – A card that features an authentic autograph.

**Base Card** – A common card in a trading card set.

**Chase Card** – A rare insert card that can be more challenging to find within a trading card product.

**Checklist** – A complete list of cards in a particular set.

**Fragment Relic Card** – A rare insert that features an embedded piece of match-used hardware, including mice, keyboards, or CPUs.

**Hits** – A term used for insert or chase cards that are randomly inserted into trading card packs.

**Ink Cards** – Cards that contain an autograph from one or more players.





**Inserts** – More difficult to obtain than base cards, these cards feature different designs and varying themes.

**Player-Worn** – A term that describes memorabilia used by a player at a specific event or match, such as a jersey.

**Parallel** – Cards that share the same design and photo but are printed using different color schemes or foil.

**Personal Collection** – A collector's favorite cards that typically are not available for trade or sale.

**Printing Plate** - Metal press plates used in the creation of a printed trading card set.

**Rookie Card** – A player's first professional league trading card.

**Serial/Crash Numbered** – A Card that is individually numbered to a specific print run. (i.e. 1/100)

**Set** – A completed grouping of base cards, subsets or inserts.

**Short Print** – Cards that have a lower print run than other cards in a particular set.
